

## JUNIOR WOMEN'S WORLD INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP

The Junior Women's World Individual event, initially staged on virtually an invitation basis, predated an accompanying team event by four years. The tournament was held every other year from 1981 to 2009, but is now played annually. Canada hosted the inaugural event in 1981, in Ottawa. The best Canadian placing has been achieved by Runa Reta who reached the quarterfinals in 1999, in Antwerp.
