1. EVENT INFORMATION

2020 World University Squash Championship

- Shanghai, China
- July 20th, 2020

Location

Shanghai, on China's central coast, is the country's biggest city and a global financial hub. Shanghai has a population of 24.24 million people.

Events / Participation / Schedule

Information concerning the event details, participation requirements and schedule will be provided upon receipt from the Organizing Committee.

2. PARTICIPANT RESPONSIBILITIES

Eligibility

All competitors must satisfy the following conditions:

- Be a national of the country they represent
- Be at least 18 and less than 25 years of age on January 1 in the year of the event
- All competitors must complete the FISU Academic Eligibility Form. The original, hardcopy form must be signed and sealed by the School Registrar and mailed to U SPORTS.

3. FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The FISU World University Championships (WUCs) are self-funded. The **estimated** cost per participant is broken down below:

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Flights & Travel Insurance

Travel should be coordinated through the participating NSO or participant directly. The anticipated travel dates would be from July 19th-July 27th, 2020.

Each team member must have valid out of country travel medical insurance for the duration of the championship in order to participate.

Visas are required for Canadians using Canadian passports to enter China for tourism or business stay under ninety days.

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Memorandum of Understanding

Each National Sport Organization (or WUC team coordinating body) must sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with U SPORTS. The MOU outlines the relationship and responsibilities of both groups. The MOU will be sent once confirmation of NSO participation is received and must be signed and submitted no later than **January 8, 2020**.

Payments

To guarantee your team's entry into the 2020 World University Squash Championship, the following payments must be made:

1. Non-refundable deposit of **\$200/participant** must be received by **January 15, 2020**
2. Final payment must be received by **June 1, 2020**.

U SPORTS will invoice each NSO directly for each of the fees owing.
