	Strongly Recommended: All players are encouraged to complete Competition Manipulation education and training through the CCES (Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport). Please note that there is a requirement to complete the Understanding Competition Manipulation course prior to accessing the Competition Manipulation Policy course. Coaches	Mandatory: To be eligible to coach in the following events outlined below, all coaches (ie. NCCP trained and certified coaches, squash pros, parents, family members, etc.) must complete CAC Safe Sport Training and/or Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders Training. No cost and requires an NCCP# to access the CAC The Locker. • Canadian Junior Open (Canadian Citizens & Canadian Permanent Residents only) • Canadian Junior Closed Championships • National Junior Circuit events Important: The new policy is NOT targeting parents that might coach their children as a one-off because their regular coach is not attending or at another court coaching another player. Parents/ Guardians	Strongly Recommended: All family members (ie. parents, guardians, grandparents, etc.) that are supervising athletes aged 18 years or younger are encouraged to complete the <i>Respect in Sport for Parents Training</i> . Cost is \$12 at the expense of the parent/guardian and requires an account with Respect Group.	Respect in Sport for Parents Respect Group	September 1, 2023
Event Volunteers	Mandatory: To be eligible to volunteer at the following events as outlined below, all event volunteers (ie. host committee, tournament director, squash pro, etc.) must complete the CAC Safe Sport Training. IMPORTANT NOTES

- Players will be required to identify coach(es) and/or family member(s) that will be accompanying them to a Squash Canada event outlined above so that all mandatory requirements can be verified as completed and appropriate accreditation made available (where applicable).
- Failure to comply with any mandatory requirements outlined above will result in the individual(s) being removed from the event with no refund and/or removed from the event site until all requirements have been completed.
- Individuals must be 14 years or older to have an account with the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC), which is called an NCCP# (National Coaching Certification Program) in the CAC Locker database.
- Online Referee Certification For players that may find the cost to complete this requirement prohibitive to participation in an event are encouraged to contact their Provincial/Territorial Squash Association and/or Squash Canada.
- All individuals subject to the Tournament Policies Matrix must adhere to all Squash Canada policies and procedures.
