All coaches are subject to the Squash Canada Screening Policy, which includes screening and safe sport requirements that must be completed immediately **upon selection** and prior to the start of engagement for the event. The requirements include:

• CAC Safe Sport training or Respect in Sport for Activity Leader;



- Consent to the UCCMS (Universal Code of Conduct to Prevent and Address Maltreatment in Sport);
- NCCP Making Ethical Decisions module and online evaluation;
- NCCP Making Headway in Sport;
- Reference Letters two required with at least one from a sport organization/club;
- Application Form;
- Screening Disclosure Form;
- Vulnerable Sector Screen with Enhanced Police Information Check (Criminal Record Check);
- Commit to Kids training [Strongly Recommended].
